



By submitting an application to a WANIC program, the student and parent/guardian agree to the following:

- I have read and reviewed the description of the program I am requesting on the WANIC website.
- If accepted, I agree to attend class on time every day.
- If accepted, I agree to complete the full year of the program for which I am applying.
- I understand I am taking a class in a separate school district. There will be different schedules and attendance policies. I understand that that I am expected to follow the calendar, schedule, and attendance policies of the school district offering the WANIC program.
- I understand I am enrolling in a multiple period class; missing one class in this WANIC program is the same as missing multiple days of a regular one period class. I will follow the attendance guidelines of the school district offering the WANIC program. My parent/guardian will excuse any absences within 48 hours and will pre-arrange any school-related absences. It is my responsibility to follow up with the teacher for any missed work due to absences.
- I have reliable transportation to and from class each day.
- I will schedule/provide ample travel-time to and from the WANIC program. I know how many miles the WANIC program is from my high school. It is my responsibility to find out what the parking policies are at the school I will be attending and I will be responsible for any parking fees, if applicable.
- I will remain aware of the scheduling differences between my school district and my WANIC program's school district. This will include differences in early release days, breaks, and teacher work days.
- I am aware of any lab or testing fees (if applicable) for this WANIC program. There may be "barrier-reduction" funds available for the 3-credit skill center programs. If I qualify for free/reduced lunch (or my family is experiencing financial hardship), I may qualify for these funds to help pay for any costs associated with my WANIC program.

Site Visit/Information:

--If the program you are applying to is in the Northshore School District (NSD), you must contact the instructor to arrange to complete a Site Visit before May 15th. For a list of instructors and contact details, go to: <https://wanic.lwsd.org/about-us/teacher-contacts>

--If you are applying to the Sports Medicine program at Issaquah High School, you must contact the instructor to arrange to complete a Site Visit before May 15th: Mr. Parsons

--If you are applying to a program located on the WANIC Main Campus at LWTech (Dental Careers, Medical Careers, Health Science Careers, or Fire & EMS), you are NOT required to attend a Site Visit. Contact WANIC directly to learn about dates of *optional* site visits.

--ALL other programs DO NOT require Site Visits.

- After your application has been approved by your high school you will be placed in the enrollment pool for this program.
- After April 15th, WANIC will email you a confirmation of your enrollment or waitlist status.
- Enrollment is dependent on district paperwork being turned in on time (if necessary), a Site Visit/Information Session being completed on time (if necessary), and space availability in the program which is determined by the school district hosting the program.

NOTE: If you do not complete the district paperwork (if necessary) or if you don't complete the Site Visit/Information Session (if necessary) by the due dates listed above, you will forfeit your enrollment and be placed on the waitlist for this class.
