The Fire & EMS course is offered through First-In Training and Education (F.I.T.E.) and is an exciting, hands-on class. Active Fire and EMS professionals teach students about fire prevention, inspection, investigation, alarm systems, dispatching, CERT, and emergency medical services. Students have the opportunity to practice their new skills at local fire stations and training centers.

After graduation, students have several opportunities to further their education, including:

- ◆ **Everett Community College (Everett, WA)**
The Fire & EMS program has an agreement with Everett Community College. The first four classes in the Fire Science program are waived due to the scope and breadth of our program. This allows WANIC students to seamlessly merge into the ECC Fire Academy, the EMT class, and the Fire Science Program.
- ◆ **Central Washington University (Ellensburg, WA)**
CWU offers a Bachelor's of Science Paramedicine degree.
- ◆ **Chemeketa Community College (Salem, OR) and University of Alaska-Fairbanks (Fairbanks, AK)**
These schools offer unique programs including many aspects of the fire service (suppression, investigation, prevention, and more). These programs allow the student to intern as a firefighter.

WANIC (Washington Network for Innovative Careers) is a regional skill center in Northeast King County. WANIC provides advanced level Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs based on rigorous academic and industry standards preparing students for career and college readiness. WANIC Skill Center programs are delivered through a system of branch campuses in eight participating districts. The skill center programs provide dual credit opportunities (both high school and college credit) and/or lead to industry certifications.
