

## Health Science Careers Nursing (NAC)



- ◆ **Location:** Sammamish HS, WANIC @ LWTech, Woodinville HS
- ◆ **High School Credits:** CTE (1.5), Health (0.5), Lab Science (1.0)
- ◆ **College Credits:** Earn up to 22 credits
- ◆ **Program fees apply** (financial assistance may be available for qualifying students)

Explore the challenging and exciting career possibilities in nursing – one of the fastest growing industries today. This intensive course of study introduces students to a variety of careers in the health care industry with emphasis on hands-on, patient-oriented skills training for those interested in becoming nurses, physicians, and other therapists. Learn about a variety of health care topics, procedures and careers in patient care, and earn certification in CPR/First Aid. Students complete clinical experience hours in healthcare facilities to meet Nursing Assistant Certified (NAC) certification requirements.

At the end of the year, students who successfully complete course requirements for NAC qualify to take the Washington National Nurse Aid Assessment Program (NNAP). Those who pass the exam can apply for certification and seek entry level employment as a nursing assistant.

The rigor required for success in this class plus college credits earned allow students to immediately enter employment in the health care industry and/or to continue their post-secondary education.
